ADULT SOFTBALL LEAGUES

TEAM APPLICATION INFORMATION 2026

Note: The 2026 Adult Softball season will be impacted by field construction beginning in late July, resulting in a truncated schedule and changes to league offerings. See below for more details.

LEAGUE OFFERINGS

Monday, 35+	Must have minimum of 4 teams, maximum of 8 teams
Thursday, Men's D1 & D2	Must have minimum of 4 teams, maximum of 10 teams per division

TEAM REGISTRATION:

To be considered for acceptance into an Adult Softball league, each manager must complete the following during the registration period:

1. **Team Entry:** visit the TeamSideline, City of Brookfield site and click the “Enroll” button <https://www.teamsideline.com/sites/BrookfieldWI/home>

2. **Team Roster:** Managers will input their team roster on TeamSideline. Managers must submit a minimum of twelve (12) players.
3. **Team Fee:** The team manager will pay the team fee on the Parks & Rec website: <https://www.ci.brookfield.wi.us/1063/Online-Registration>

INDIVIDUAL PLAYERS will receive an email invitation from TeamSideline after the manager inputs your name and email onto the team roster. Follow the instructions provided in the email invitation to complete setup.

REGISTRATION PERIOD 1

Monday, February 2 – Friday, February 20, 2026

Who's Eligible to Register:

1. Returning Teams
2. New Resident Teams (will be placed on a waitlist pending league openings).

- A resident team is defined as a team with a minimum of four (4) City of Brookfield residents.
- Resident Team Fee: **\$604.00**
- Returning Team Fee, less than 4 residents: **\$654.00**
- Deadline for returning teams to register: Friday, February 20, 2026
- New Resident Teams added: Monday, February 23, 2026
- Returning teams registering after the deadline will be placed in the league as space allows.

REGISTRATION PERIOD 2

Monday, February 23 – Friday, March 14, 2026

Who's Eligible to Register:

1. New, Non-Resident Teams

- Non-resident teams are defined as teams with less than four (4) City of Brookfield residents.
- Non-resident team fee: **\$654.00**

LEAGUE FEES:

- Team fee: **\$604 resident/\$654 non-resident** per team, due in full at the time of registration.
- The team fee is based on player residency listed on the tentative roster, if residency on the final roster is not verified, any additional money will be due prior to your first game.
- Once paid, all fees are NOT refundable or transferable.
- Payment may be made in cash, credit card or check. All checks should be made payable to "Brookfield Parks and Recreation Dept."

PLAYER REGISTRATION

Before participation, individual players will be required to create a user name and password on [Team Sideline](#) and complete their player profile, sign the league waiver and upload an ID.

LEAGUE SCHEDULE:

- Monday, Mens 35+ will begin on **April 20** and will conclude on **July 20**
- Thursday, D1 & D2 will begin on **April 23** and will conclude on **July 23**.
- All leagues will have 12 regular season games scheduled.
- Playoffs/Championship Game:
 - Monday, Mens 35+
 - Top 4 teams in the standings will make the playoffs.
 - Playoffs/championship game will be played on July 20.
 - Thursday, D1 & D2:
 - Top 6 teams in the standings will make the playoffs (each division)
 - Playoffs/championship games will be played on July 23.
- Each league will have one (1) rainout date built into the schedule; any games cancelled beyond that date will not be rescheduled.

MANAGER MEETING:

- **Wednesday, April 1, 6:00 p.m.** Senior Community Center, Multi-Purpose Room.
- Team materials will only be distributed to the team manager or a rostered player from the team who attends in place of the manager.

NEW TEAMS

New teams must enroll their team in TeamSideline plus pay the team fee. The team fee will be held pending acceptance into the league. Team fee must be cash or check, no credit cards accepted until time of final payment.

PRE-SEASON PRACTICE REQUESTS:

A practice field request form will be emailed to all managers after team registration is complete. Practice field assignments will be issued at the manager meeting in April. Practice spots will be available April 18-22.

FREE AGENTS:

A list of people seeking teams is available at the Parks and Recreation office if your team needs additional players. Individual players seeking a team may submit their names to the Parks and Recreation office for potential placement on team, team placement cannot be guaranteed. A player cannot be an official member of more than one team on any league night.
