

YMCA of Metropolitan Dallas Fall 2025 Shootout Tournament

Shootout Tournament is open only for the branches of the YMCA of Metropolitan Dallas hosted by Richardson YMCA. Registration is open for the following divisions: 1st to 6th, boys and girls. Coed plays in boys division.

Friday, Nov 7 and Saturday, Nov 8

Hosted by the Richardson YMCA

Location: RD Family YMCA, Custer Park, Heights Park, FUMCR church, and Lookout Park in Richardson.

1st and 2nd place medals in each league.

Team Registration Fees:

For Richardson Fall 2025 teams there is \$130 deposit, \$100 Refundable after tournament*

Additional DFW YMCA teams:

1st-2nd grade: \$180 deposit, \$100 Refundable after tournament

3rd-6th grade: \$250 deposit, \$100 Refundable after tournament

Team Rosters: All teams must turn in (e-mail) from your YMCA sports director OR your sports director can e-mail a copy to richardsonsports@ymcadallas.org . Richardson teams do not need to turn in a roster. We will provide that for you.

Guest Players: Registered guest players (3max) are allowed under the following rules:

- Coaches must first invite all players on their 2025 Spring Soccer team. The coach cannot have a guest player whose team is also registered to play in the tournament.
- Guest players must be added to your team roster by your YMCA Sports Director.
- Guest player must be a registered player on a 2025 Spring Soccer YMCA team.
- Guest players must wear a team jersey/t-shirt with jersey number.
- Academy or competitive players (under team contract) are NOT allowed to guest play on a YMCA recreational team in the tournament if they are not currently registered on a Fall Soccer YMCA team.
- A team cannot exceed maximum roster by adding guest players. For example: if a 1st grade team has 8 regular season players available for the entire tournament, only 2 guest players are allowed as maximum roster is 10 players. Guest player number is based on the highest number of regular season players available for the entire tournament, not per game. Maximum 3 guest players per team.
- Guest player addition deadline: Oct 31, no exceptions.

Tournament Format: Single elimination. Brackets are formed by blind draw - not end of season placement. This gives lower placed teams an opportunity to move forward rather than the traditional format of playing their first game against the 1st place team and possibly being eliminated. Winning teams advance. If game ends in a tie after one overtime, the winner will be determined by penalty kicks.

Registration Deadline: Oct 31, 5p or when divisions are full, whichever occurs first. * Roster due Nov 1

Game Schedules: Released by Mon, Nov 3 11:59pm. No tournament game conflicts will be accepted. If you cannot play, per the game schedule, it will be an automatic forfeit.

- Please note: Registering on time does not guarantee placement. Please review League Formation information in the tournament rules.

Tournament Teams and Guest Registration

Coaches/managers must log in to your YMCA registration account and choose yourself or your player as the participant. You will be able to add team information before checking out.

Be sure to register your team correctly. If your team plays league soccer with the Richardson YMCA, register as a Richardson YMCA team. If your team plays league soccer with a different YMCA register as an Additional YMCA team. If you register incorrectly, your team will not be added to the tournament roster.

Our registration system does not have the ability to close divisions once full even if your registration processes. You will receive a separate e-mail from the Richardson YMCA which will be your final confirmation.

Tournament Divisions

1st Grade Girls, 1st Grade Boys, 2nd Grade Girls, 2nd Grade Boys, 3rd Grade Girls, 3rd Grade Boys, 4th Grade Girls, 4th Grade Boys, 5th/6th Grade Girls, 5th/6th Grade Boys

Refund and Fair Play

In fairness to all, the deposit fee is non-refundable if a team:

- 1: Forfeits or no-show's a game. (minimum roster and registered coach must be on the field within 5 minutes of official start of game.)
- 2: Is found to have a non-registered, non-rostered and/or unapproved player on the team or playing field.
- 3: Cancels after the May 13th deadline.
- 4: Intentionally does not play all players 50% of each game.
5. Teams will not be accepted after Oct 31.

Inclement Weather Policy

Rainout: If inclement weather cancels the tournament prior to the first scheduled game on Nov 7, all teams will receive a refund equal to 50% of the entry fee to cover start-up cost of the tournament. If inclement weather cancels the tournament after scheduled games have started and games can't be rescheduled, no refunds will be issued because of costs incurred.
