



Middle School, High School, Adult Divisions:

Pool play is two sets to 25 points in 4-team pool play. Pool play is three sets to 25 points in 3-team pool play. All pool play games capped at 30. Team standings determined by games win/loss record. If tied, then standings determined by total points. If still tied, teams will battle to five points rally scoring.

Bracket play will be single elimination. Best 2 out of 3 with a tie 3rd set will be played to 15 points.

Rally scoring will be taken in every match.

A coin flip or Rochambeau will determine who get serve or side.

Co-Ed net height 7'8"

Absolutely NO coaching on side line unless approved by Tournament director.

Any side line coaching will be warned once then if continued person will be asked to leave or team may be asked to forfeiting game if person continues to be a distraction to the game.

No open hand tips are allowed . Player's shoulders must be "squared " to the net with ball when pushing the ball over the net open handed. Ball can NOT be double hit.

A touch on a block does not count as a hit.

Player do not have to rotate positions on the court but they do have to rotate servers.

1 time out is allowed to each team per set of a 30 second duration period.

Player serving may have one opportunity to serve the ball over the net.

No subs will be allowed during game unless approved by appointed Richland Parks and Rec staff.

No block on serve.

NO Open hand touch is allowed on serve receive.

A served ball may contact the net.

Players will officiate as design on pool play and bracket play schedule.

In an instance of a disagreement or unseen call a "replay" may be called by Officiating team or appointed Richland Parks and Rec staff.

NO foul language, verbal abuse, or physical abuse will be allowed or tolerated at anytime.

No touching the net or going under the net is allowed while in play.

All scores will be reported at check In location by officiating team after each set is complete.
