<u>The League</u> — 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13 year olds games are played against other Conroe United teams. No travel teams. No standings are published and no tournaments are played. Our league is for fun!

Coaches— All coaches are volunteers, must pass a background check, and attend a coaches meeting. Awards— the league does not provide any form of trophies. Post season trophies and medals are optional at the parent's expense.

Uniforms — every child will receive a reversible jersey. Black shorts and black socks are optional and provided by the parent.

Shoes— no boots or similar type shoe will be allowed on the court during games.

Teams — will be assigned after player evaluations and coaches will be assigned a roster at coaches meeting. You will receive a phone call from your coach about practices and other information.
