<u>Practices</u>— held once per week for all teams, 8-13 year olds may practice twice per week. Practices are 5:30- 6:30pm or 6:30-7:30pm, Monday-Friday, at Carl Barton, Jr. Park soccer fields and will be scheduled by your coach.

Games — played at Carl Barton, Jr. Park on Saturdays mornings and afternoons starting at 8:00am.

The League — 4, 5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13 year olds games are played against other Conroe United teams. No travel teams. No standings are published and no tournaments are played. Our league is for fun! The 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13 year old divisions will be separated boys and girls if they have the numbers.

Coaches— All coaches are volunteers and must pass a background check, attend a coaches training and meeting. Awards— the league does not provide any form of trophies. Post season trophies and medals are optional at the parent's expense.

Uniforms — every child will receive a soccer jersey (shirt only), black shorts and black socks are optional and provided by the parent.

Equipment — shin guards are required and provided by the parent, soccer shoes/cleats are optional.

Teams — will be assigned after mandatory player evaluations and coaches will be assigned a roster at coaches meeting. You will receive a phone call from your coach about practices and other information. If you have not heard from a coach by February 26, email Wes Wagner at wwagner@cityofconroe.org.

Playing time — all players will play at least half of every game; players will have the opportunity to play different positions, no player may play the same position group more than 2 quarters.

What if it rains on our practice day— Check the Rainout line @ 936-522-3919, check the Conroe United Facebook page, and ask your coach for updates for if the fields are available for practice.

What if it rains on our game day— The Rainout line and Facebook page will always be updated as soon as possible if it has been raining or if there is rain in the forecast. If you are unsure, arrive at your game field at least 30 minutes prior to your game time and check with your coach.
