LEAGUE PHILOSOPHY



The Parks and Recreation Department sponsors an adult athletic program that stresses high participation, recreation and sportsmanship. The City provides these quality services through a variety of structured leagues which include:

- Mens Basketball in the winter, summer and fall.
- Womens Basketball in the winter, summer and fall.
- Coed Cornhole in the spring and summer
- Coed Kickball TBD
- Coed Softball in the spring and summer.
- Mens Softball in the spring and summer.
- Coed and Reverse Volleyball in the winter, spring/summer and fall.
- Womens Volleyball in the summer.

The City runs each league according to established rules, regulations, a Code of Conduct, and consequences specific to each sport. Adult athletic participants are subject to basic rules which emphasize sportsmanlike behavior and the recreational nature of City leagues.

Players shall not...

- Verbally abuse, threaten, lay a hand upon, push, shove, or strike an official, player, or spectator.
- Refuse to abide by an official's decision.
- Object to an official's decision through verbal abuse or throwing an object.
- Use unnecessary rough tactics against another person with the intention of causing injury.
- Display unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Be intoxicated immediately prior to or during a game. Alcohol is not allowed on-site.
- Smoke/vape at any recreation event.
- Leave trash outside of receptacles provided.
- Challenge an official's authority to impose penalties for violations of the code of conduct.

Manager, player, or spectator intimidation of game officials and violations of league rules will result in a game forfeiture. Umpires have authority to monitor and discipline any individual within the ballpark during the game. The decision of the umpire is final in all cases. Cases will be sent to league supervisor for further review and subsequent action.
