**General Statement of Duties:**

This position involves routine semi-skilled work relating to the operation of street department type equipment along with the maintenance and minor repair work on buildings, grounds and equipment. The Recreation Director who provides direct supervision to this position specifically makes work assignments.

**Essential Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

- Ability to understand and follow directions;
- Ability to perform routine maintenance on equipment and grounds and buildings;
- Ability to get along well with others; courtesy, dependability, thoroughness, general good physical and mental condition.

**Acceptable Experience and Training:**

Some experience in routine maintenance, completion of a standard high school curriculum or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.

**Additional Requirements:**

- A valid Wisconsin driver's license is required.
- Must be 18 years old or older.

**Physical Requirements:**

- Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.
- Ability to lift 70 pounds from ground level to a height of 3 feet.
- Ability to perform duties requiring manual dexterity.
- Ability to operate mechanical and motorized equipment for long periods of time.
- Ability to climb ladders.
- Ability to concentrate for long periods of time.
- Corrected vision and/or hearing (if needed).
- Ability to negotiate rough terrain.
