



Men's Basketball League Waiver/Roster

Final rosters must be turned in to the Athletic Supervisor **before the FIRST game** is played. *Any team with no completed roster will not be allowed to begin the season and all monies paid will be forfeited.*

Any person who does not provide ALL the above information is not allowed to play in the league. Any player found to be violating this rule will be suspended and the team will be fined.

By also signing this roster, I agree to the Bolingbrook Park District Adult Athletics Code of Conduct. – See below for 'Code of Conduct'

ADULT ATHLETICS CODE OF CONDUCT

(adopted November 2006)

1. Any unsportsmanlike behavior such as abuse of equipment, taunting, etc. displayed in a game, or after a game shall automatically disqualify the offending player or captain for the next game on a first offense, and for the rest of the season (including any post-season play) for the second offense. These are automatic suspensions.
2. **PROFANITY RULE:** Each 'Bolingbrook Park District Adult Athletic League' has a "Profanity Rule." For exact policy specific to each sport, please see the "sport specific rulebook."
3. **Any physical conduct / fighting with another player, coach, spectator, official/umpire or Bolingbrook Park District employee before, during or after a game will not be tolerated.** Any player and/or coach participating in any physical conduct will be automatically suspended for a minimum of one (1) season with possible league suspension and civil action. The team will also be fined \$25 per individual suspended. This fee must be paid prior to the team's next game or a forfeit will be enforced. Teams will not be allowed to replace the suspended player on their roster.
4. Any player who verbally threatens a player, coach, spectator, official or Bolingbrook Park District employee before, during or after a game will be suspended a minimum of one(1) season with possible league suspension.
5. Persistent poor behavior, including harassment of officials/umpires or other teams, (aka "trash talking") may result in the dismissal of that team from league and loss of returning team status. Teams exhibiting such behavior will receive a written warning from the Athletic Supervisor. Issuance of a second warning for team misbehavior will result in that team being placed on probationary status with possible individual suspensions to follow.
6. **Teams are responsible for the conduct of their spectators.** Spectators' behavior can result in the same suspensions as stated above.
7. **The Bolingbrook Park District will be implementing a 3-strike policy for alcohol in all of our adult athletic leagues.**

Strike 1 – First time an umpire sees alcohol they will stop the game and ask team(s) to remove the alcohol from the fields, coolers need to be removed and placed in cars.

Strike 2 – Second time an umpire sees alcohol they will stop the game and ask team(s) to remove the alcohol from the fields, The Park District prohibits any type of alcohol on park district property.

Strike 3 – Third time, the umpire will stop the game due to team(s) refusing to comply with the park districts rule on alcohol, game will result in a forfeit for the team not complying with the rules. If both teams do not comply with the rules the game will still end in a forfeit.

*Spectators can and will be escorted from the park if caught with alcohol.

***Any games forfeited due to the 3-Strike policy will not be open for appeal and will not be rescheduled.**

8. Any drugs (unless prescribed by a physician) are prohibited on Park District property. The following applies to parking lots as well as all Park District facilities.
 - a. If any Players or teams are caught with drugs during a game, the officials will pause the game and give a verbal warning to remove the substance from the field.
 - b. If Players or teams are caught with drugs and do not remove from field the team's current game will be forfeited resulting in the opposing teams win. If both teams are caught and do not remove the substance, the game will be forfeited and will not be rescheduled or replayed.

- c. Spectators can and will be escorted from the park if caught with drugs.
 - d. Bolingbrook Park District and Village Police are empowered to issue tickets to violators in addition to the penalties listed above.
9. **Any player ejected from a match must leave the fields immediately. An ejection will result in an automatic one game suspension for the next game/competition. Multiple game or season suspensions could be given out depending on the severity of the ejection.** Before a suspended/ejected player is reinstated into the league, a \$25 suspension fine must be paid to the Park District office no later than 24 hours before the next scheduled match. Failure to do so will result in continued suspension until the payment is made.
10. During a player's suspension, the player can not attend any scheduled games of the Bolingbrook Park District soccer league. Any player which plays during a suspension will be considered an illegal player and the team will forfeit the game.
11. The Athletic Program Manager has the right to disqualify any player or team from league play due to unsportsmanlike conduct with no league refund.
12. Teams will not be able to replace a disqualified player(s) on their roster at any time.
