

Lightning Warning

LIGHTNING IS A SERIOUS HAZARD. IF YOU SEE LIGHTNING OR HEAR THE WARNING HORN (ONE 15-SECOND BLAST), STOP ALL ACTIVITIES AND SEEK SAFE SHELTER IMMEDIATELY. ACTIVITIES MAY RESUME ONLY AFTER THREE 5-SECOND HORN BLAST AND THE STROBE LIGHT STOPS FLASHING. IF YOU STAY OUTSIDE AFTER A WARNING, YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK.

SEEK A LARGE BUILDING FOR SHELTER.

GO INTO YOUR CARS.

AVOID: OPEN AREAS, WATER, TALL TREES, METAL FENCES, OVERHEAD WIRES AND CELLULAR POLES.
