Security Requirements & Acknowledgement

To help ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for all guests, the City of Escalon Recreation Department may require private security services for Community Center rentals.

Please read the information below carefully. By signing this form, you acknowledge and agree to the listed requirements and responsibilities.

Security Requirements

- Two (2) on-site security guards are required for:
 - Large events with more than 100 attendeesAny event serving or allowing alcoholic beverages, including BYOB events

Security personnel must remain on-site for the entire scheduled event time. This does not include set-up or cleanup hours.

Security is not required to be armed; however, individual security companies may have their own policies depending on the type of event.

Renter Responsibilities

The renter is responsible for:

- Coordinating directly with a licensed security provider if security is required
- Paying all security-related costs directly to the provider
- Providing proof of booking or a copy of the security contract to the City at **least 30 days prior** to the event
- Ensuring security personnel remain on-site during the required event hours
- Following all Community Center rules and regulations

Failure to comply with security requirements may result in:

- Cancellation of the reservation
- Denial of facility access
- Withholding of security deposit funds if applicable

The City of Escalon does not set or control pricing for private security services.

Approved Security Vendors

Any licensed security company may be used. The following vendors are currently pre-approved by the City of Escalon:

Rank Investigations & Security

Use of a security company not listed above requires prior approval from the Chief of Police.

Possible Security Waiver

Security requirements may be waived by the Chief of Police on a case-by-case basis.

Factors considered may include:

- Type of event
- Time of event
- Potential for incidents

Events that may qualify for a waiver include:

- Work or Corporate Events
- Celebration of Life or Funeral Services
- Wedding Anniversaries

If a waiver is granted and police respond to a fight or alcohol-related incident during the event, the renter's security deposit may be withheld.

By signing below, the renter acknowledges that the City of Escalon Community Center Security Requirements have been read and understood.

The renter agrees to comply with all applicable security requirements, including providing proof of security services when required.

The renter understands that failure to comply with these requirements may result in cancellation of the reservation, denial of facility access, and/or withholding of the security deposit if applicable.
