

## Attending MSCR Middle School games Attendance Guidelines

- 1. Unsupervised youth of any age may not attend games.
- 2. MSCR Staff may supervise groups of youth to attend HOME Games
  - a. MSCR staff should not bring spectating students to AWAY Games
  - b. Staff must be actively supervising students.
  - c. Supervising staff should not be the coach/scorekeeper
- 3. Adult family members may attend games
  - a. Adult family may include extended family or family friends
    - i. MSCR staff do not need to closely monitor this as long as spectators are not being disruptive
  - b. Adults may bring youth who are in their immediate family
    - Adults should not bring youth who are from extended family or unrelated. This could be approved by Site Director in special cases.
    - ii. Spectating adults are responsible for active supervision of youth who attend games with them.
    - iii. MSCR staff do not need to closely monitor this as long as spectators are not being disruptive
- 4. Adult or youth spectators may be asked to leave the school grounds if they are (after 1 warning):
  - a. Being disruptive to the participants or other spectators
    - i. Excessive volume
    - ii. Offensive language
    - iii. etc.
  - b. Are not exhibiting good sportsmanship
  - c. Are acting in a manner deemed inappropriate for the setting.
