



Attending MSCR Middle School games **Attendance Guidelines**

1. Unsupervised youth of any age may not attend games.
2. MSCR Staff may supervise groups of youth to attend HOME Games
 - a. MSCR staff should not bring spectating students to AWAY Games
 - b. Staff must be actively supervising students.
 - c. Supervising staff should not be the coach/scorekeeper
3. Adult family members may attend games
 - a. Adult family may include extended family or family friends
 - i. MSCR staff do not need to closely monitor this as long as spectators are not being disruptive
 - b. Adults may bring youth who are in their immediate family
 - i. Adults should not bring youth who are from extended family or unrelated. This could be approved by Site Director in special cases.
 - ii. Spectating adults are responsible for active supervision of youth who attend games with them.
 - iii. MSCR staff do not need to closely monitor this as long as spectators are not being disruptive
4. Adult or youth spectators may be asked to leave the school grounds if they are (after 1 warning):
 - a. Being disruptive to the participants or other spectators
 - i. Excessive volume
 - ii. Offensive language
 - iii. etc.
 - b. Are not exhibiting good sportsmanship
 - c. Are acting in a manner deemed inappropriate for the setting.
