

Playing Up Regulations

- 1. Teams can only call up to get their roster to nine (9) players.
- 2. Only 12 year old's can play up to the Pony League and 10 year old's to the National League.
 - Age Exception: Must be approved by the Director of Baseball Operations
- 3. Rookie League cannot play up to the American League without prior approval from the Director of Baseball Operations.
- 4. All callup players **MUST** start the game.
- 5. Each player must play the league minimum number of innings.
- 6. Callup players cannot play more innings than a regular roster player.
- 7. A manager in need of a callup may select from any team in the league below.
- 8. The callup player cannot pitch or catch.
- 9. The callup player wears their own uniform.
- 10. Sock color rule is waived for the callup player.
- 11. Current team commitment takes priority when a scheduling conflict occurs.
- 12. Parents or guardians must sign the **play up liability waiver** for their child to play up. This is available online and must be completed before the player can play up.
- 13. Any violation of these regulations will result in a forfeit for the offending team.
- 14. The manager who calls up a player must make the opposing manager and the umpire aware of callups during ground rules.
- 15. All call up players must abide by the league specific rules which includes equipment.
