



Frequently Asked Questions

- Can my son play with his grade?
 - Yes, players are allowed to play with their classmates. Please email hapdumont@gmail.com with proof of grade to receive an exemption.

- What division should I sign up for?
 - Single A- this is for Rec Level teams or lower teams from competitive leagues.
 - Double A- Competitive League and Semi-Travel Teams.
 - Open- This is geared for AAA/Major teams.

- How many tournaments must I play to qualify for State?
 - Must play in one tournament or play in an affiliated league.

- What are the affiliated leagues?
 - Genesis Sports Complex, Salina Rec League, Westurban Baseball, Southwest Boys Club, Sunflower Sports League

- How does seeding at State work?
 - Teams will be seeded off points. Teams may be moved around to avoid teams from the same city/league playing each other in pool play. Teams with the highest points total will have a chance for a bye in the bracket play, if applicable.

- How can I earn a free birth to State?
 - If you play in 7 Hap Dumont tournaments you will receive a free birth to state.

- How do the three divisions work at state?
 - There needs to be at least 6 teams to make a division work. If there are not 6 teams in a division, divisions will be combined. If there are more than 8 teams in a division, we may split into two brackets after pool play.
