

HAT DRAW ULTIMATE RULES SUPPLEMENT

1. All players must be **officially registered with the City of Eugene to participate** in the league. Either registered for the whole season or register for the specific day. All players must be 14 years of age or older to participate in the league.
2. **Number of players on the field: Seven (7). Ratio of Men-Women:** 5 men and 2 women comprise a field team. However, it is the two team captain's responsibility to establish any ratio before the start of each game that best ensures equal playing time for players of both sexes based on the number of players present at the start of the game.
3. **Arriving late:** Teams must have a minimum of 6 players present (at least two men and two women) to start the game (when the horn sounds). Teams are encouraged to play a "practice" game if a team forfeits.
4. All games will be played to **21 points (teams must be ahead by two)**, 90 minutes. Teams either finish out the point they are playing, or if the teams are between points they play the next point. The team that is ahead wins the game, regardless of the score. If the teams are tied after the regulation time, the next team to score wins. (Time/points may be shortened by mutual managers consent in the case of hot weather/lack of players)
5. Home team must supply the game disc, a 175 gram "ULTRA STAR" unless another disc is agreed upon by both captains.
6. **Cleats** are recommended, however, players may not use cleats which have any metal exposed.
7. **Uniforms:** The team listed as home will wear black, visitors wear white. Please keep one shirt of each color with you at every game.
8. **Score keeping:** Flip chart scoreboards will be available for use during all games. Winning teams are responsible for reporting final game score to the supervisor at the conclusion of their game.
9. **Zone Defense:** Zone defense is not allowed during summer league. If you are guarding a "space" and not a player, it will be considered an illegal "zone defense".
10. **Alcoholic beverages** are **not allowed** in park, parking lot or school grounds.
11. Teams must **alternate throw-offs** between males/females.
12. The USA Ultimate Official Rules of the Sport of Ultimate, eleventh edition will govern all rules not covered in this rules supplement.
