SUMMER 2022 COED ULTIMATE RULES SUPPLEMENT

- 1. All players must be **officially registered with the City of Eugene to participate** in the league.
- Players may be added to a team only if the team captain requests additional player(s) due to injuries or players not showing up to games. The Athletics staff will add a comparably skilled player from the waiting list. PICK UP PLAYERS ARE NOT ALLOWED WITHOUT ATHLETICS STAFF APPROVAL (IF APPROVED, A \$5 PER GAME FEE WILL BE CHARGED)
- 3. **Number of players on the field: Seven (7). Ratio of Men-Women:** 5 men and 2 women comprise a field team. However, it is the two team captain's responsibility to establish any ratio before the start of each game that best ensures equal playing time for players of both sexes based on the number of players present at the start of the game.
- 4. **Arriving late:** Teams must have a minimum of 6 players present (at least two men and two women) to start the game (when the horn sounds). Teams are encouraged to play a "practice" game if a team forfeits.
- 5. All games will be played to **21 points (teams must be ahead by two),** or 1 hour 30 minutes (90 minutes). After 90 minutes elapses, the horn is sounded. Teams either finish out the point they are playing, or if the teams are between points they play the next point. The team that is ahead wins the game, regardless of the score. If the teams are tied after the regulation time, the next team to score wins. (Time/points may be shortened by mutual managers consent in the case of hot weather/lack of players)
- 6. Home team must supply the game disc, a 175 gram "ULTRA STAR" unless another disc is agreed upon by both captains.
- 7. **Cleats** are recommended, however, players <u>may not use</u> cleats which have <u>any metal</u> exposed.
- 8. **Uniforms:** The team listed as home will wear black, visitors wear white. Please keep one shirt of each color with you at every game.
- 9. **Time outs:** Each team is permitted three (3), one-minute time outs per game. Timeouts cannot be called in final 5 minutes of each game.
- 10. **Score keeping:** Flip chart scoreboards will be available for use during all games. Winning teams are responsible for reporting final game score to the supervisor at the conclusion of their game.
- 11. **Zone Defense**: Zone defense is <u>not</u> allowed during summer league. If you are guarding a "space" and not a player, it will be considered an illegal "zone defense".
- 12. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in park, parking lot or school grounds.
- 13. Teams must alternate throw-offs between males/females.
- 14. No team bench or spectator viewing is allowed on either sideline of the Century Middle Field.
- 15. League Format: four teams will play a double round robin which will determine seeding for the final Best match game.
- 16. The USA Ultimate <u>Official Rules of the Sport of Ultimate</u>, eleventh edition will govern all rules not covered in this rules supplement.
